3.1 Race 2017 or Not to Race

C Porter described the outbreak at his loft and how he contracted the virus. The bird mortality was only 1% at C Porters loft. There were strong views why we should not race and strong view that we should race. This was discussed at length and W Garner moved a motion, second L Vanderlinde that we race in 2017. The members voted 39 in favour of racing with 13 against. Carried

W Reese asked when we should race. There were concerns that some lofts were not yet infected and how that would impact their race season. This was discussed at length with many views on what we should do. A Kitching moved a motion, second W Garner that we race in six weeks 17 June 2017. L Vanderlinde amended that motion, second C Porter that we race in two weeks 20 May 2017 and then stop and see what happens. The members voted in favour of racing in six weeks 17 June 2017. **Carried**

The members asked that the management committee to set up the new race schedule. W Reese said that could only happen if we knew how many members were flying the new schedule. W Reese called on all secretaries to contact members and provide a list to the management committee by Monday the 7 May 2017. It was also discussed that the management committee would set dates for training on the QRPF transporter. Dr R Marshall was thanked for his time and will provide guidance to the QRPF through the 2017 race season.
