7. Business Arising from the Minutes

7.1 QRPF INVESTMENT

B Snyman received information from Bendigo bank that the renewal notice for term deposit will expire mid-August and then the QRPF may lodge another term deposit application. B Snyman will lodge the application.

7.2 Pigeon Product sales

B Snyman has received sample from Avian company to show members what products are available. Member can place orders with their Club secretaries and pass on the orders to QRPF secretary. Only if there is enough interest for a Full Pallet will the QRPF place the order.

7.3 QRPF Old Transporter

The Old QRPF Transporter was sold with all the old Steel crates.

8. General Business.

8.1 Letter from M Frame - Pittsworth

M Frame is seeking transport for his pigeons on the west route. The Management committee is happy to supply M Frame with transport on the following condition:

\$30 per crate with a Max limit of 30 birds liberated with QRPF race birds.

\$20 per crate for Training crates unlimited released with QRPF trainers.

Crate numbers to the QRPF flying rules.

Birds need to be at the west section before transporter arrives.

8.2 Letter from LCPC - Basketing

LCPC wanted to enquire how some clubs are allowed to basket their race team in one basket and not have their birds mixed up with other members. The Management committee advised that it has been practiced for decades that all pigeons are mixed when basketing for any QRPF race. The Members also have a due diligence not to basket sick pigeons for any QRPF race. B Snyman outlined that there was no written rule that says birds are to be mixed up. B Snyman moved a motion, second C McDonald that all pigeons shall be mixed up when basketing for any QRPF race. The Management committee reserves the right to inspect any basket. **Carried.**

8.3 Bird Escaped from the Race basket

R Walker outlined how one race bird escaped from the race basket when it fell. The bird was timed in early in the morning and reported to the president. No Action was required as the West did not have competitive bird in QRPF fed results. All clubs have been advised to please seal both ends on the race crate doors on basket night.

8.4 5 Birder races

B Snyman wanted to remind all members that its compulsory \$5 entry fee for all birds entered in the 5 Birder races. The prize money is paid on a ratio of every 5 flyers one prize paid out. Club secretaries to collect money on Basket night and QRPF secretary will invoice each club.

8.5 Stamp off Early

B Snyman wanted to know if the management committee was flexible to allow clubs to stamp off earlier so that some old members could avoid driving at night. The Management committee did not want to change it now, but will look at the rule change at the AGM.
