7.1 Bulk PMV orders

B Snyman outlined the quote from Scolexia. The Management Committee have agreed to order 20 Bottles of PMV vaccine and Clubs can order /purchase Vaccine bottles from B Snyman.

8. General Business

8.1 LCPC Letter (Breaking Point)

LCPC are wishing to include a Breaking point from Bundaberg for the 2027 season. The Management committee is happy for LCPC to present their rule change at the AGM in 2027 for the members to vote on. B Snyman will send out the 21-page document for members to review.

8.2 M Reynolds one Birder

C Porter has proposed to the management committee to continue hosting the M Reynolds one birder on the Cunnamulla National. The management committee was in favour of this. The Members shall enter the 5 birds in the National and then nominate one bird of the 5 birds to enter the M Reynolds One birder. The cost would be \$25. A Nomination form to be completed and submitted on basket night. Payment to be made to the Club Secretaries. The QRPf treasure will invoice all clubs.

8.3 Proposed Race schedule for 2027

R Larson requested a copy of the 2027 race schedule. B Snyman shall forward a copy to all clubs to review before the special general meeting 31 October 2026.

L Vanderlinde enquired if any other members are experiencing issues with the new QPF life rings. L Vanderlinde has rung 7 youngsters and after two months of flying around all 7 rings have cracked. Member to please report any similar issues.

8.5 \$100 Fuel levy for 2026 season

B Snyman requested if the management committee shall consider refunding the additional fuel levy charged for the 2026 season. The management committee outlined that fuel cost has already double compared to the 2025 season and we have not even finished the season. Due to the ongoing high costs of fuel and the extraordinary race schedule. The Management committee shall not refund the \$100 for the 2026 fuel levy.

8.6 North Pick up for 2027 season

B Snyman enquired if the three Northern clubs of the QRPF wish to be picked up in 2027 on route to the race point every week. This is important to know before we have special general meeting as we might have to pick up three clubs, this would have an impact to the scheduled time of arrival at race points.

8.7 Community Loft Applications

B Snyman enquired if members we aloud to race in Community loft & from their own back yards. The management committee has set up the Community loft for members who can not fly from their own back yards and all applications shall be reviewed and approved based on merit. All who wish part take in Community loft have to be members of QRPF and submit an application to enter the community loft.

8.8 Breeder plate 2027

B Snyman outlined that the QRPF shall host the Breeders plate for 2027 and shall notify all when dates are confirmed for the auction venues. The same rules shall be applied at the 2026 season. Also, the Gauntlet race shall be hosted.

8.9 North Gold Coast Pigeon club

I McDonald has advised the NGCPC shall close its doors for the 2027 season. All current members shall join LCPC.
